

Members are invited to submit nominations for APSA's Lifetime Achievement Award. The nomination should include a short statement of the nominee's achievements.

- (i) Any individual currently or formerly employed in tertiary education, who self identifies as a student of politics, is eligible.
- (ii) Normally, the nominee will have contributed to both the discipline and the profession in Australia.
- (iii) The closing date will be 30 April 2007.
- (iv) No more than two awards will be made in any one year.
- (v) The decision will be made by a committee chaired by the President plus two nominees by the APSA executive.
- (vi) The award will be made at the APSA annual Conference dinner.
